**SPONSOR EXPO AND FAMILY FESTIVAL KEY COMPONENT IN SUNDAY'S THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL'S
RACE FOR FETAL HOPE DENVER**

Denver, CO, November 2, 2009 – While many local residents will register as a participant of the Denver Race for Fetal Hope slated for Sunday, November 8th, many more will participate because of the growing Sponsor Expo and Family Festival that is a key component of each race in the National Race Series. The Denver race will kick off at 10 a.m. with a 5k run/walk with a free Kids Fun Run and will feature one of the largest post-race expos and Family Festivals around.

The Race for Fetal Hope Denver's Family Festival is sponsored by the National Organization of Mothers of Twins Clubs (NOMOTC) which is dedicated to supporting agencies and organizations with a common mission of furthering research and supporting multiple birth issues. Due to their involvement, large groups of moms of twins and local support clubs get involved by forming teams and enjoying a day with their families.

The NOMOTC Family Festival will include games, refreshments and live entertainment provided by local 80's tribute band, RETRO. Local celebrities and mascots such as Ronald McDonald will also be on hand to sign autographs and entertain fans and children alike. New to Colorado, the Avalanche's mascot, Bernie, will be making his first public appearance as part of the Kids Fun Run.

The Race Committee anticipates crowds exceeding 1,500 for the day's festivities with all proceeds benefitting the Fetal Hope Foundation, the only national organization focused on advocacy for spreading awareness of and funding research for various fetal distresses and syndromes.
